## Headteacher's Message



Dear Parents/Carers,

It has been a very warm week at Osborne Primary School this week and it has been lovely to see the children enjoying the sunshine. We had a wonderful time at our Reception, Key Stage 1 and Key Stage 2 Sports Day and it was lovely to see so many parents and carers there to cheer their children on. I would like to publicly say a HUGE thank you to our wonderful PE Leader Miss Parnaby for working hard to organise such a lovely sports mornings for us.

As temperatures are set to be high early next week, SCHOOL WILL BE OPEN but I just wanted to reassure you that we are preparing for this eventuality by following our extreme weather risk assessment. Please see below some of the measures we will be putting into place for the safety of the children.

### SCHOOL WILL:

- Make sure that there will be regular work breaks, where we will remind pupils to drink
- Ensure classrooms are ventilated as well as we can
- Plan appropriate activities that suit the weather conditions
- Monitor and reduce the length of time children spend on the playground as necessary
- Ensure staff are aware of the signs of heat exhaustion

### PARENTS ARE ASKED TO:

- Send their child in light, loose fitting clothing, with shoulders covered (e.g. shorts and a t-shirt), as we will be relaxing school uniform on Monday and Tuesday (school uniform on Wednesday please).
- Send children with sunhats from home.
- Apply sunscreen before children come to school.
- Send your child with a labelled plastic drinks bottle containing fluid - not fizzy or energy drinks. Cold water will be available for them to refill bottles.
