We are learning about the seasons and the beauty of Spring. We will be thinking about how seeds grow and investigating where our fruits and vegetables come from. We will also be exploring different plants.

Understanding the World

- Introduce the children to recycling and how it can take care of our world. Look at what rubbish can do to our environment and animals. Create opportunities to discuss how we care for the natural world around us.
- Make comments on the weather, culture, clothing, housing.
- Change in living things – Changes in the leaves, weather, seasons, Explore the world around us and see how it changes as we enter Summer. Children to note and record the weather.
- Look at the immediate environment, introducing and modelling new vocabulary where appropriate.
- Encourage interactions with the outdoors to foster curiosity and give children freedom to touch, smell and hear the natural world around them during hands-on experiences.
- Look for children incorporating their understanding of the seasons and weather in play.
