



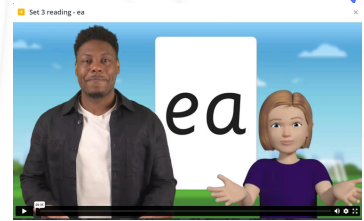

Reading at home



At the start of the year, from Monday to Thursday you will receive a link to a video which will help your child to practise the sound they have learned that day.

Please watch this video with your child.



In Reception, later on in the year, your child will bring home a colour-banded book. You should try to read this book with your child for at least ten minutes every night. The colour-banded book your child brings home will match the phonics group they are in.
