Reading at home



Reading at home every day for at least ten minutes will improve children's reading.

- Osborne pupils will bring home two reading books each week (this may not change each week based on the size of the book) in their Osborne book bag.

Books

A colour banded book - this is a book your child should be reading independently.

A library book - this is a book your child has chosen because it interests them. You may need to support them with the reading or read it to them.

Note down what your child has read and any comments you have about their reading on Boom Reader.

Pupils need to bring their books in their book bag in every day.



Online Home Learning

All pupils should access Oxford Reading Buddy or Reading Plus at home.

- Pupils read books allocated to them by Class Teachers.
- Pupils take quizzes to demonstrate their understanding of the book.

Spelling at home



Pupils in Years 3-6 will be working on set spellings each half term.

These spellings are listed on our school website in each year group's section of the website.

- Pupils will have 10 spellings per week.
- Children should practise these spellings at home at least three per week.

Practice 1: Child look at the spelling, say the spelling, cover the spelling, write the spelling and then check.

Practice 2: Child look at all of the spellings. Parent/Carer say the spelling, child write the spelling and then check. Repeat practice 1 for any incorrect spellings.

Practice 3: Child look at the spellings incorrect from practice 2. Parent/Carer say the spelling, child write and then check. Repeat practice 1 for any incorrect spellings.



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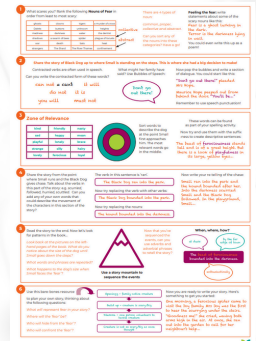
Writing and Grammar at home
